#### Masses Return to the Shrine Church What You Need to Know

There is still no obligation to attend Mass because of the Coronavirus pandemic. Even though we will resume Masses this Sunday at the usual 9:30 am and 12:00 pm, persons who are vulnerable are encouraged to stay at home. Since all will not be able to attend Mass at church, our Masses will continue to be available on Facebook. Fr. O'Connor has named Don Arnold as our Shrine Coordinator of "Returning to Mass Safely".

No one should come to church if they have a fever of 100° or higher, are experiencing any Coronavirus symptoms, or have been exposed/tested positive for the Coronavirus.

#### **Procedures:**

- 1. All must enter the Church using the Lake Avenue entrance and have their name and phone number taken at the door. Face masks must be worn from the time you leave your vehicle to come into Church until you return to your vehicle after Mass.
- 3. All will be escorted to a place to sit, directed during communion, and dismissed to exit the church.
- 4. Singing can cause the virus to travel longer distances so all should listen, not sing to the beautiful music.
- 5. At all times, six feet social distancing must be observed.
- 6. Do not gather in groups before or after Mass. After leaving Church, go directly to your car or bicycle.

# **Holy Communion:**

The advice from the health community and the Albany Diocese **strongly encourages** us to receive the Body of Christ in your hand. Then as you turn away from the minister of the Eucharist lower your mask, consume the Body of Christ, and then raise your mask again. This helps protect not only you and but others who distribute and receive the Holy Eucharist.
